COVID - 19 RESPONSE

STAY IN PLACE and STAY SAFE ORDER

On March 25, 2020, with support from the Local Health Authority and all Mayors of incorporated municipalities within Burnet County, County Judge James Oakley enacted a Stay in Place and Stay Safe Order for all of Burnet County, Texas.

The order takes effect at 11:59pm Wednesday, March 25, 2020 and continues until it is extended, rescinded, superseded or amended in writing by the Burnet County Judge.

This order requires nonessential businesses to close temporarily. Essential businesses are defined in the order and described below. Any business not listed in the order as essential must close to the public and Burnet County residents working for a nonessential business are required to stay home and not travel to their place of employment.

The intent of this order is to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

ONLY LEAVE HOME TO:

use social distancing by at least six feet of space

- Visit a doctor
- Visit a dentist
- · Visit a healthcare provider
- · Go to a grocery store
- · Pick up food from a restaurant
- · Go to work at an essential business

- · Go to pet supply store
- Go to home improvement store for essential items for well-being at home
- Engage in outdoor activities (walk, jog, ride a bike)
- Care for family members or pets at another household

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- All public and private gatherings (more than 10 people)
- · Visiting nursing homes/retirement centers
- · Use of public playgrounds

- All elective medical procedures
- In-person religious services and gatherings allowed only by video or teleconference

Minutes of General Meeting – March 12, 2020
Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Call to Order and Opening Ceremonies: In President Stripling absence, Member-at-Large Gail Teegarden welcomed everyone at 11:31 and invited them to the buffet lunch. Gail called the general meeting to order at 11:56. Debbie Bindseil gave the Invocation and Mary Moore led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Recognition of Officials, Guests, and New Members: Elected officials, Precinct Chairs, TFRW Officers, new members and guests were introduced.

Program: Mary Jane introduced speaker, Marie Leffingwell, who is with the Trump campaign in Texas Marie's topic was "Trump Victory Leadership Initiative. She spoke of the importance for everyone to be engaged and to get out the vote. It is important to work to elect all Republican candidates down ballot not just the president. All down ballot candidates in the district have tough races with Democrat opponents. Voter registration is utmost in the minds of the Texas Trump campaign. With the Red Dialer program, the campaign has been able to identify trouble areas such as Houston and Dallas. It is a call to action – make phone calls, register people, block walk, have house meetings, and watch parties. Posting on social media should use the #Lead Right to verify it is legitimate. All volunteers need to stress Trump's accomplishments especially second amendment rights. This initiative needs more certified deputy voter registrars. Certification is very easy to attain and well worth doing. In closing, Marie called everyone to action. The Senate must be held and the House flipped.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes were approved as published.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Carolyn Richmond reported \$14,062.80 in the treasury and \$898.09 in the Scholarship Fund. There are still some Chili Cook-Off receipts to be added.

Reports of Other Officers and Standing Committees:

- Membership: Dottie Stueckroth reported 2 new members and 3 renewals for a total of 68 members.
- · Campaign Activities: Mary Jane Avery reported that a building has been donated for Republican Headquarters. It is located at 2212 Hwy 281 in Marble Falls. There are already 10 sponsors. \$200 /month is needed to pay for utilities and other expenses. There is a plan and strategy for getting people registered and out to vote a strike force to block walk, the Red Dialer program, and "house parties."
- By-Laws: Janet Crow reported on the TFRW Leadership training program she attended. The amendments the BCRW proposed were approved. There will be other TFRW amendments and changes which will come later that will have to be brought up for discussion and passed.
- · Caring For America: In Jessica's absence, Gail reported on the contributions made to the Highland Lakes Pregnancy Resource Center. Many items for new babies were donated to the center as well as gift cards and cash donations. Other Reports:
- · Burnet County Republican Chair: Kara Chasteen recognized all members who worked polls on primary day thanking them for volunteering. She mentioned the Precinct and County Conventions will be held at the AgriLife Building at 9:00 am on

March 21.


