## **OCTOBER MINUTES**

**Burnet County Republican Women PAC  
Minutes of General Meeting – October 8, 2020  
Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas**

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Kay Stripling welcomed everyone to the BCRW October 8, 2020, in-person regular meeting at 11:33 a.m. A baked potato w/stuffing and dessert had been placed at each person's table setting. County Commissioner Damon Beierle gave the invocation, and Darlene Hargett led the pledges to the American and Texas flags.

Recognition of Officials, Guests, and New Members: Elected officials, precinct chairs, and TFRW officers introduced themselves. Guests and new members were also introduced. President Kay recognized our speaker Tom Maynard, incumbent and candidate for the State Board of Education. We also had special guests Chief Justice Jeff Rose, incumbent and

candidate for Texas' Third Count of Appeals and Superintendent of the Marble Falls ISD, Dr. Chris Allen.

President Kay brought everyone's attention to a table to her left where Mary Jane Avery and Roxanne Nelson are hosting a table where we can sign up to volunteer as an electioneer at the three polling locations.

Program: Gail Teegarden addressed the group to introduce Tom Maynard, our representative on the State Board of Education. She described his amazing history and how he went from a Boys Ranch to the State Board.

Tom spoke to the group about how the State Board of Education works, how they work with the state in guiding our school systems and still work within the guidelines of the State rules. After a very informative program Tom asked Dr. Chris Allen of MFISD to join him in answering questions from the group giving a more personal reply to the questions.

At the completion, President Kay asked Tom Maynard to remain up front for a moment and also invited Chief Justice Jeff Rose to join. She then presented each candidate a check for \$1,000.00 from BCRW-PAC to their campaign. Londa Chandler then came to the front and gave each gentleman a check for \$1,000.00 from the BCRC also for their campaigns.

Approval of Minutes and Treasurer's Report: The minutes of the September 10, 2020, meeting as recorded by Janet Crow, acting secretary for Janice Estill, were approved as published.

Treasurer Carolyn Richmond reported the operating account funds total \$16,549.07 as of October 1, 2020; a separate \$6098.09 is designated for the Scholarship Fund.

Reports of Other Officers and Standing Committees:

- Membership: Membership Chair Janice Estill announced we currently had a total of 85 members and 23 associates. Please remember to renew.
- Bylaws: Two by-law changes were read at the last meeting by Janet Crow, By-law Chair. Janet Crow read the new Article #5 and Article #6. President Kay asked for a motion and second on The Article #5 change. The motion was made by Carolyn Richmond and seconded by Rosanne Nelson. The motion carried. Next, President Kay asked for a motion and second on the Article #6 change. The motion was made by Janet Crow and seconded by Darlene Hargett. Motion carried.
- Approval of Nominations Committee: President Kay announced that she had failed to take a vote to approve the Nominations Committee at the last meeting and asked that we do so now. The committee is made up of Gail Teegarden, chair, Dottie Stueckroth and Carleen Kaurin . A motion was requested. Motion was made by Janet Crow and seconded by Joyce Smith. Motion carried

- Campaign Activities: Chair Mary Jane Avery announced that we need volunteers for electioneering at 3 locations. Mary Jane thanked the Red Dialers which were recognized at the meeting, and for the block walkers that had worked in Sun City, Georgetown, Round Rock and Taylor. She had all walkers at the meeting stand. She also announced that we would be walking for Chip Roy in Travis county next week.

- Campaign Contributions Committee: Our committee made up of Mary Jane Avery, Gail Teegarden and Judy Salvaggio have completed their work on the Campaign contributions. President Kay thanked them for the job they had done. Kay announced that you can find a list of the campaign contributions that BCRW made to Republican candidates in key contested State level races on each table. We were able to donate \$8000 this year and this is an amazing job. It came from a lot of hard work— the GOP picnic and BC GOP headquarters brought in a lot of these funds. Thank you to all who worked on the picnic and to Dottie Stueckroth for getting our headquarters location through Dr. Horis Stedman. And a thank you to Londa who kept our Headquarters stocked.

- Caring for America: President Kay announced "Our Caring for America project today will benefit the Highland Lakes Pregnancy Resource Center, which offers Pro-Life support through pregnancy test, support groups, educational classes and more to pregnant women. Our items today will go to their Baby Boutique.

Other Reports:

- Burnet County Republican Party Chair: Kara Chasteen, County Chair, reported that at present



time all positions for the elections have been filled. She thanked all for volunteering.

- Burnet county Republican Club Chair: Londa Chandler thanked everyone for the time spent walking and knocking on doors. She said a lady had told her that it had been proven that for every 14 doors we would pick up 1 vote—and every vote counts.

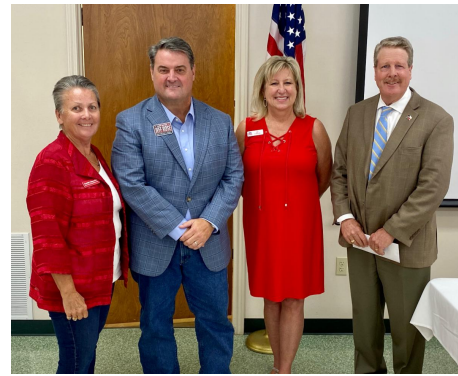
With no further business and no objection, the meeting was adjourned at 1:17 P.M.

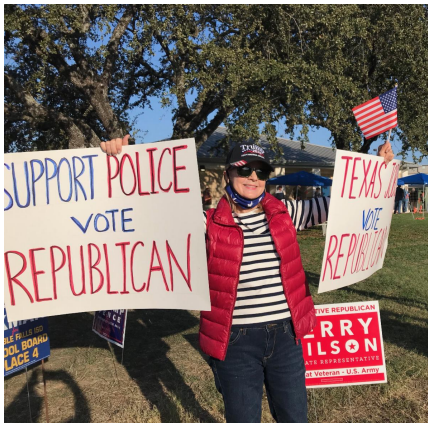
